

B Visa for Tourist and Business Purpose

The B-1 (for business purposes) visa recipient may receive from a U.S. source payment for reasonable incidental expenses while in the US for a business purpose, and within the effective dates of the visa. Incidental expenses include lodging, meals, laundry, travel (such as bus, taxi's), etc. NWRA may also pay for travel to and from the U.S.

NWRA may NOT pay for any salary, consulting fee, nor honorarium. Certain institutions may pay an honorarium and they are:

- Institutions of higher learning
- Non profit
- Government research institutions

These institutions may pay honorarium or fees under certain circumstances, however, this does NOT apply to NWRA. We may only pay *expenses* under a B-1.

A B-2 visa is for tourism only. We cannot pay expenses under a B-2.
